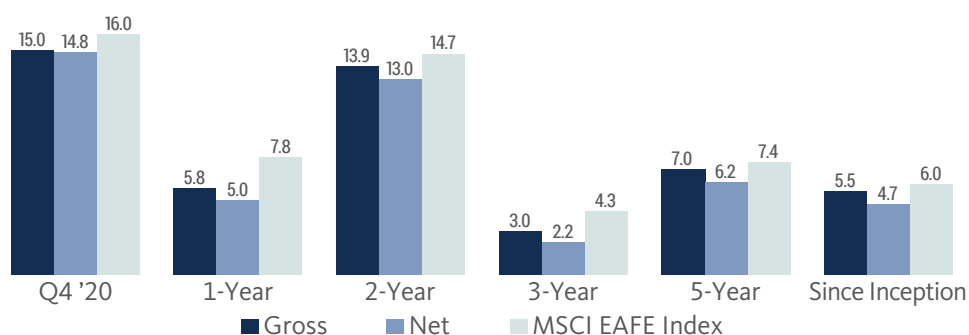

INVESTMENT APPROACH

- Stocks are ranked based on a multi-factor model that includes valuation, improving fundamentals, and momentum.
- Stocks ranked in the top quartile are selected from within 15 Affinity-defined sectors.
- Control for risk factors relative to the benchmark, including sector neutrality, region, and country.
- Alpha is generated almost entirely from stock selection.

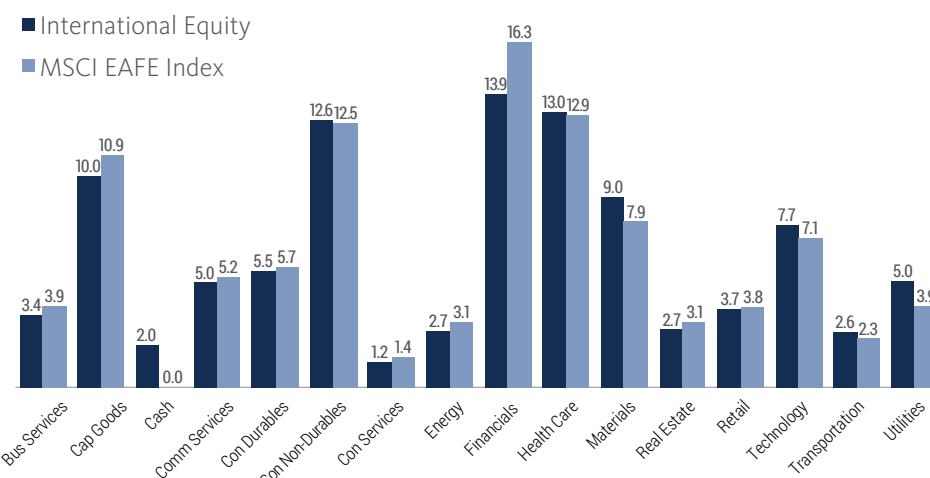

The International Equity Composite contains fully discretionary international equity accounts. The composite strategy seeks superior returns relative to the MSCI EAFE (Net) benchmark by employing a time-tested quantitative strategy with a fundamental overlay. The creation date of this composite was December 31, 2014. On January 1, 2016 the benchmark was changed from the iShares MSCI EAFE Exchange Traded Fund (EFA) to the MSCI EAFE (Net) due to availability constraints. The MSCI EAFE (Net) benchmark is a better representation of the strategy and therefore the change has been made retroactively back to the composite's inception.

Affinity claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards.

Affinity has been independently verified for the period July 1, 1992, through December 31, 1992, by BDO Seidman and the periods January 1, 1993, through April 30, 2007 and November 1, 2010 through December 31, 2016 by Ashland Partners & Company LLP. For the period January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2019, Affinity has been independently verified by ACA Performance Services, LLC.

Verification assesses whether (1) the firm has complied with all the composite construction requirements of the GIPS standards on a firm-wide basis and (2) the firm's policies and procedures are designed to calculate and present performance in compliance with the GIPS standards. The International Equity composite has been examined for the period December 31, 2014 through December 31, 2019. The verification and performance examination reports are available upon request.

Results are based on fully discretionary accounts under management, including those accounts no longer with the firm. Past performance is not indicative of future results. 100% of the composite is made up of non-management fee paying accounts for the period inception through June 30, 2015. As of December 31, 2015, 1.7%

of the composite is made up of non-management fee paying accounts. As of December 31, 2016, 2017, and 2018, 0% of the composite is made up of non-management fee paying accounts. As of December 31, 2019, 0.5% of the composite is made up of non-management fee paying accounts.

The U.S. Dollar is the currency used to express performance. Returns include the reinvestment of all income. Gross returns are stated gross of all fees and net of transaction costs. Net of fee performance was calculated using the product's standard annual fee of 0.75% applied monthly for all periods shown.
